#### SANTA LETTER WRITING PROGRAM

Santa Letter Writing program is our Heritage. In 1989 the Heritable Club was officially involved with the program. During Chrismas 2017 we had 480 Heritage Club volunteers from 17 chapters who answered 167,320 letters with a total hours of 10,581. We answered 8,252 letters after Christmas. In 2017, posters were created for daycare centres as well as schools and we replied to 5,252 schools. A total of 1.6 million letters were answered in the 2017 Santa Program.

We need to increase the number of volunteers across Canada. It is our commitment to reply to all letters that we receive. We reply letters in 27 languages plus brail.

#### COMMON BLOOD PRESSURE AND HEART DRUG RECALLED

Health Canada and the US Food and Drug Administration have announced that a number of drugs containing the medication VALSARTAN have been recalled.

The manufacturers of several drugs containing VALSARTAN issued a recall recently due to fears that the ingredients had been contaminated by a chemical know as N-nitrosodimenthylamine (NDMA), which is classified as a possible carcinogen.

The VALSARTAN involved in the recall comes from a single manufacturer – the Chinese company Zhejiang Huahai Pharaceuticals – but is used in drugs from a number of companies.

If you are taking a medication containing VALSARTAN, Health Canada advised you not stop unless told to do so by a doctor or pharmacist – it can be very dangerous to suddenly stop any prescribed medication. Keep taking your medication and consult your pharmacist, who can tell you if your medication is one of these affected by the recall and switch you to another VALSARTAN drug. (In Canada, out of all 4.4 million prescriptions for VALSARTAN drugs, the recalled drugs accounted for 25 millions). If you been taking the recalled drugs, consult your doctor about treatment options.

VASARTAN is used in treatment of high blook pressure and to prevent heart attack and stroke. It is not certain yet how the contamination occurred, but according to European Medicines Agency, which also announced a recall, it is believed to have happened during the manufacturing process, which recently underwent changes. What is known is that the drug no longer meets the safety standards.
