Cancellations

It is with considerable disappointment that in response to the COVID-19 virus, Parkland Chapter must announce the cancellation of several Heritage Club activities, and services for 2020.

The decision follows increasing and overwhelming concerns about the COVID-19 virus in our region. We felt this was the best way to proceed as the most important thing is the health and wellbeing of our members.

The list below details the status of planned activities that have been delayed, cancelled, or postponed.

All Quarterly Luncheons have been cancelled. - we will re-visit this decision in September 2020.

<u>The Annual Spring BBQ has been cancelled</u> – we hope to be able to resume this popular event in 2021.

The Fall Banquet has been cancelled - - again, we plan to resume this popular event in 2021.

The 2020 Festival of Trees has been cancelled - the festival will not be held this year.

<u>Monthly Food Bank volunteer events</u> are postponed– currently the Food Bank is operating with minimal volunteers to maintain social distancing. We will re-visit our involvement when the Food Bank begins more normal operations.

<u>Monthly Bowling events</u> are postponed – bowling alleys are expected to remain closed for some time. We will re-visit when bowling alleys are re-opened.

<u>Monthly Golf events are postponed.</u> Although golf courses are now open, we will wait a bit to ensure that this activity will not have any negative consequences. We may re-visit our decision on golf in early summer.

A decision on the 2020 Santa Letter Writing Campaign will be made in September or October.



A Reminder ...

HERITAGE CLUB SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM - 2020
