You may want to print/save it and keep it with your financial or estate paperwork.

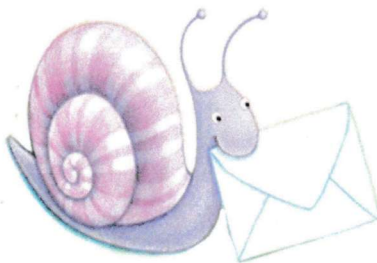
