Pension report issue (again)...

If you have received your personalized pension statement for 2025 you will have likely noticed the issue with the post-retirement survivor benefits section, in that it shows the amount from when you retired

not the cost-of-living adjusted per-month amount, occurred again this year. This problem popped up last year when a new provider – AON – took over the management of the program. The National Executive was assured the issue would be corrected in this year's report, but it was not. This is extremely disappointing. The National Executive has reached out again, but... sigh... I'll share the response we were given last year, which is that the benefit hasn't changed, survivor benefits are adjusted for cost-of-living, but the entry in the statement is from the year you retired.
