President's Message

Dear Members,

I apologize for the long delay in newsletters. This year has been extremely complicated, between personal family issues, Canada Post strikes and unbeknown to our heritage members, Canada Post has removed all support to our Heritage Club members and chapters. The most devastating is the removal of our mailing privileges/subsidies. Our National Executive committee has been working to obtain some form of compensation in line with our members' contribution to CPC related activities such as community grant and scholarship evaluations, Santa Claus letter writing, community charity fund raising and community volunteering.

During the last Heritage Club Presidents' Conference, it was agreed by all the chapter presidents that, until CPC provided some compensation and recognition of the Heritage Club support to CPC, the chapters would not support CPC projects. Therefore, I will not be supporting any of the above noted CPC initiatives. I will ask members to show who would be interested in participating in the activities (Santa Claus Letter writing), only if our Executive is able to reach a satisfactory solution. If CPC is unwilling to support our members, then we will not support CPC.

I have tried to recruit members to volunteer and participate with the Golden Horseshoe Chapter but to date, I haven't been very successful. Most of my Golden Horseshoe Executive have experienced health issues this year, like me, and I am so appreciative of them for providing whatever support that they could. I encourage you to add whatever support that you can to the Golden Horseshoe Chapter and help us to strengthen our commitment to our members and to improve our service. With the issues of Canada Post, now cancelling our annual funding, as well as our mailing privileges, it is now quite a bit more costly to mail out our newsletters and keep our membership informed. You will notice smaller fonts used, less content in the newsletters and fewer newsletters, all to keep costs down. Also, this will be the last total mailing to all available (retired) CPC employees. Newsletters will only be provided to paying members and newly retired members, this allows the newly retired to become a paying member.

I'm optimistic that the Heritage Club, now in it's 36th year, can persevere. It is so nice to maintain ol' friendships and keep the camaraderie going.

Note: our paid membership currently has now reached 125 members: Thank you!

In the past, our Golden Horseshoe chapter has sponsored 6 Mandarin lunches, in Burlington and Hamilton.

Of the many events/programs our chapter participates in, we would like to remind you that individual community service participation is also recognized. You will find a ballot at the end of this newsletter to record your community participation. Your community participation can be anything which supports your community (hospital volunteer, meals on wheels, etc.). To recognize the contribution of our members community support, the Golden Horseshoe Chapter will have for volunteers a \$50 gift card draw at the end of December.
