

Next stop: <u>Chatsworth Farm Orchard & Cidery</u>, The Home of Clockworks Cider.

Daube MacGregor is a pediatric neurologist at SickKids Hospital in Toronto. She lived at Chatsworth on her farm for over 30 years with her daughter who runs the farm. Three years ago, she had a dream to create a cidery in their classic Ontario bank barn, building the orchard, production house and agri- tourism destination. Next: <u>Holstein General Store</u> in Holstein Ontario. Brian Plume and Dee Dee Eurig brought the Holstein General Store last year and excited to breathe new life into the community's business. Their store was a way to support local mom and pop businesses in the area. They have had an overwhelming response to the store, they have expanded their range of products including an LCBO location.
