## A POSTAL SERVICE STORY

The Ottawa Post Office, circa 1877



The Ottawa Post Office, Customs & Inland Revenue building, was once the pride of Ottawa. Built in 1876, the building was located where the National War Memorial sits today. The building was used as a Post Office until 1936, and then demolished in 1938.

The "old" post office, as it was lovingly remembered, was, according to the *Ottawa Citizen* newspaper, "one of the prettiest public structures in Canada", with a Romanesque-revival facade, mansard-style roof, and fourteen figureheads representing mythological and historical characters, acting as keystones.




