

Email from JP Leguerrier, National Heritage Club President:

"Jim would be proud to know his research is still being used in the Canadian Forces Postal Service (CFPS) in their research of their origins." I was just using some of the Heritage Club historical material Jim Bain sent me for the CFPS history update. Wonderful work and historically valuable to Canada Post and the CFPS.

"I am pleased to report that the CFPS (Canadian Forces Postal Service) history update is complete in terms of a working draft. I am now editing, adding some additional photos and cleaning it up in the hope of presenting it to CFPU in October in time for their 50th anniversary celebrations."

The above excerpt is from an email that JP Leguerrier sent to us sharing comments from his contact at the Canadian Forces about how invaluable Jim Bain's research over the years has helped with their own history. (Jim Bain passed away in April 2024)

Jim was passionate about his research of the Canada Post employees who served in the wars, making contact with their families and creating a document with so many of their profiles.

He also envisioned and created the "Honouring our Own" ceremony held each November, initially in the lobby of the VMPP and later in the Richmond PPC plant for employees and Heritage Club

members to remember.



This year's ceremony will be held on **Friday, November 7, 2025 at 10:30 am in the PPC** in Richmond. Please mark it in your calendar and plan to attend to view and recognize the meaningful work Jim Bain did and to remember all of our fallen Posties.
